**RIALACHA:**

College rules will be explained clearly to students on their first day.

1. Sí an Ghaeilge an teanga labhartha le linn an chúrsa. Students are not permitted to speak English during the course. Our attitude towards this rule is firm and those unwilling to make an effort to speak Irish will be sent home.
2. Entry into licensed premises or the consumption of alcoholic drink is strictly forbidden during the course.
3. Smoking is forbidden on the course.
4. Students must not absent themselves from the guesthouses after 10.00 p.m. and remain there until after breakfast.
5. Swimming/fishing is only allowed under the supervision of a member of college staff.
6. A student may not leave the college during the course without permission of the Príomhoide.
7. As with normal school discipline policies, misbehaviour, verbal or physical intimidation, intentional or otherwise will be dealt with accordingly by the college authorities.
